Sustainable/active travel could also save you money when compared with owning and running a private vehicle.

Additionally your local surroundings would benefit from sustainable travel by having reduced: traffic congestion, carbon emissions, general pollution and noise.

As set out in the Government's Transport White Paper, Creating Growth, Cutting Carbon - Making Sustainable Local Transport Happen (DfT, 2011), it is keen to promote these sustainable travel benefits to people at key "life changing" moments such as moving to a new home or starting a new job.

The White Paper particularly targets short-distance local trips, under five miles in distance, as those with the biggest opportunity for sustainable travel uptake (from private vehicle use to cycling, walking and public transport use etc).

ACTIVE-TRAVEL WALKING

King Edward VII Estate includes numerous amenities within its grounds, accessible by a short walk, as follows:

- 🛓 A gym
- 🛓 A swimming pool
- 业 Communal rooms in The Sanatorium
- 🟦 Commercial services in The Chapel

King Edward VII Estate also includes six kilometres of reinstated Dr. Bardswell's Measured Walks around the estate grounds.

Numerous Public Rights of Way and public leisure walks are accessible from King Edward VII Estate such as The South Downs National Park Authority's 'Midhurst, Woolbeding and Easebourne Walk' to the South.

ACTIVE~TRAVEL CYCLING

King Edward VII Estate includes secure cycle parking spaces in both the East and West courtyard basement car parks and in individual garages to encourage cycle ownership and use.

Several local and National Cycle Network (NCN) routes are within a short cycle distance of King Edward VII Estate. The map, bottom right, shows the closest cycle routes (green routes are traffic free routes, purple routes are on-road routes).

NCN Route 22 (Farnham to Banstead) is to the West.

NCN Route 223 (Chertsey to Shoreham-by-Sea) is to the East.



PUBLIC TRANSPORT

BUS

King Edward VII Estate has access to Stagecoach's 70/71 bus service from a pair of bus stops located at the junction of Henley Hill the A286 with King's Drive. A summary of Stagecoach's 70/71 bus service is provided in Table 1.

Residents aged 5-19 that are in school or full time further education can apply for a 3inl card. More details are available at www.westsussex.gov.uk/education-children-and-families/your-space or from your Travel Plan Coordinator.

The development will also look into the provision of a mini-bus service for commuters to the railway station and periodic trips into nearby Midhurst. The availability of this service will be subject to demand.

Before the shuttle bus is operational, discounted taxi fares will be negotiated with local taxi firms. Contact your Travel Plan Coordinator for further information.

RAIL

Haslemere and Guildford Railway Stations are the closest to King Edward VII Estate and will be accessible using the shuttle bus.

Local and national destinations are accessible from these stations.

CAR CLUB
